Leticia Hernandez is a single mom of two children who is challenged with inadequate housing. Leticia is faced with the stress caused by the cost of renting her three bedroom townhouse apartment that does not accommodate the needs of her family. Leticia's son, Rolando, has a rare chromosome abnormality which has affected his development in many ways. Rolando's medical conditions and the equipment needed to care for him do not allow him to use his bedroom upstairs. The living room has become his bedroom and the place where Leticia sleeps to care for him. Leticia said she is most excited to have a

one story home with a living room that is a living room, a bedroom for her son and a backyard for both children to play.

A Habitat home for this family means a place for everyone to grow and a sense of financial accomplishment for Leticia, while investing in her own home. Habitat for Humanity of Wood County Ohio wishes the Leticia continued success toward homeownership. The house for the Hernandez family was originally built by Habitat in 2015 in partnership with Penta Career Center's Construction Program and was recently repurchased by Habitat. The home will be refreshed and sold to Leticia, through an affordable 0% interest 25-30 year home loan, upon her completion of the homeownership program in 2021.
