

Bowling Green Roof Repair Project

Evonna's home was in need of repairs. Her roof was in poor condition, leaking around the skylights and at the seams. She had no way of making the repairs herself and being on fixed income, was

unable to hire a contractor. So, Evonna contacted Habitat and she was able to get approved for a roof repair project.

During this project a contractor removed the skylights, replaced rotten wood sheeting, and installed new GAF dimensional shingles. A Community Development Block Grant from the City of Bowling Green provided the funding for this project. Evonna can now stay in her home which is decent, safe and affordable, for many years to come.
